Through this support, we were able to launch the inaugural Tett Artist Residency program, offer artist talks, workshops, and our well-loved Kids Creativity Club and Tett Tuesday programs.

As a new core program, the Tett Artist Residency offers access to studio space and career development opportunities for emerging artists. This program builds exciting opportunities for professional growth and foster connections across communities in Kingston and beyond. Funds raised last year enabled us to enact outreach plans, work with a community-based jury for the artist selection process, connect with residency applicants in meaningful ways, and outfit Studio B in order to welcome our first artist-in-residence in January 2023.
